May 31 - Trinity Sunday

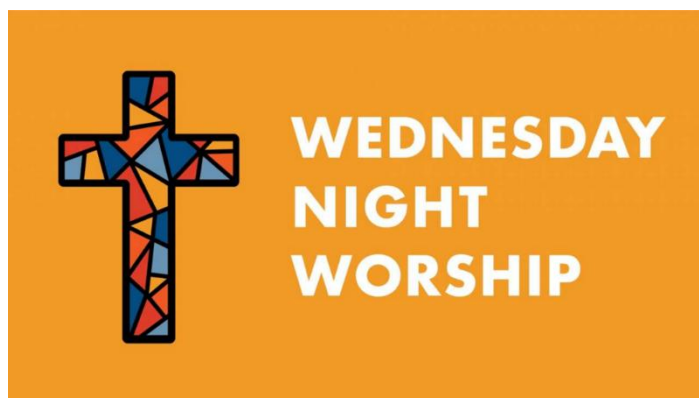
