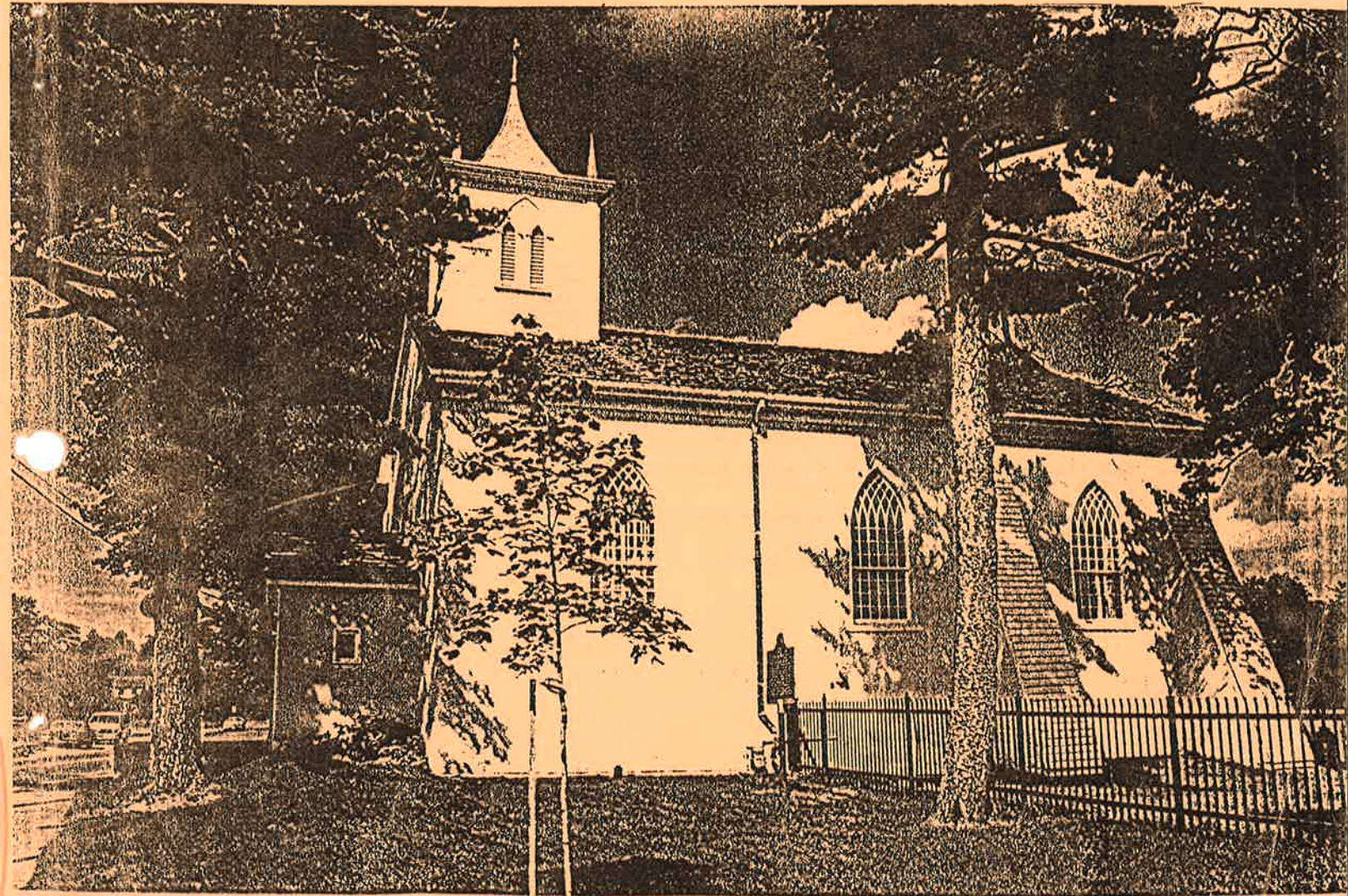

### FORWARD & ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS



## THE HISTORY OF

### ST. JOHN the EVANGELIST ANGLICAN CHURCH

In 1818 the Anglicans had no church closer than Queenston. On February 10, 1818 a petition was forwarded to the Lord Bishop of Quebec saying that money had been subscribed for a church.

By 1822 services were being held in this new parish known as Holy Trinity Anglican Church, with William Leeming as the Rector. Samuel Street and Thomas Clark gave the land for the church and cemetery.

Sir Peregrine Maitland was appointed Lt.-Governor of Upper Canada in 1818. He had a summer home (Stamford Park) built on the north-west corner of Portage Road at Mountain Road. He saw a need for a place to worship.

Capt. Robert Henry Dee, a member of the Lt.-Governor's staff donated a parcel land on the east side of the Portage Road for the church. The date of this deed of property is September 20, 1820. A parish of an Episcopal Church at Stamford was begun.

The exterior of the Church was of rough-cast, except for the porch and buttresses which are believed to have been added at a later date. The tower was also covered with rough-cast after the turn of the century.

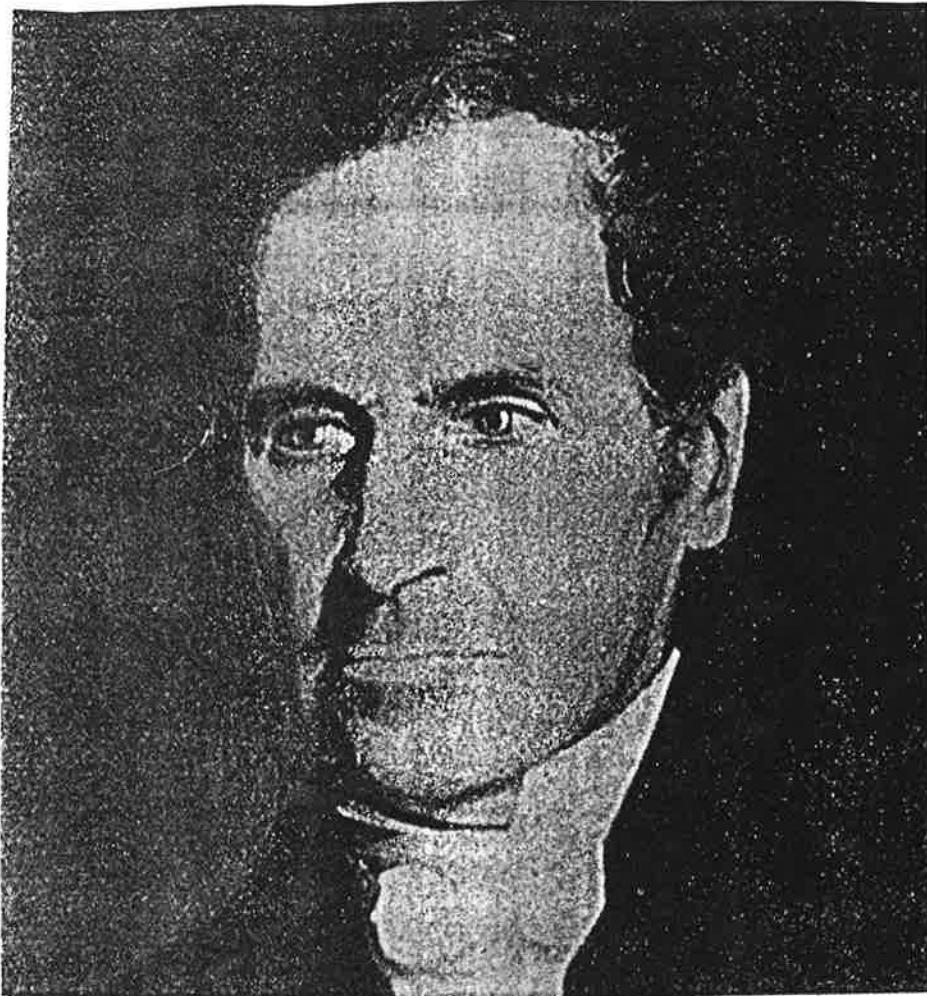
On each side of the entrance on the inside of the Church was a small room, one a vestry, the other a cloak room with stairs leading up to the gallery (used by the choir).

High-backed box pews lined the nave. A very high walnut pulpit stood at the right front with a high walnut reading or prayer desk at the left.

The Communion Rail extended across the building with a simple Communion Table within. Five large gothic-styled windows of clear glass could be found in the body of the Church. Heating was provided by two wood-burning stoves.

Many offerings provided the funds from which the building was financed. (See the itemized account of materials and labour required to prepare the Church). The Church was nicely furnished through parishioners donations.

On September 25, 1825 the Lord Bishop of Quebec, the Honourable Charles James Stewart, consecrated the Church, to be known as the "Church of St. John the Evangelist". Reverend William Leeming was Rector of the new parish.



**REVEREND WILLIAM LEEMING**

Mr. Leeming was born in England, Feb. 25, 1787, educated at St. Bede's College, Cumberland and came to Canada in 1819 as a missionary of the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel. He was appointed by the Bishop of Quebec to the parish of Chippawa which then encompassed Stamford, Drummondville, Fort Erie, Thorold and St. Catharines but which had no church buildings. He was married in 1823 in Stamford by his brother, Rev. Ralph Leeming of Ancaster and built or bought a home for his bride on Highland Ave. just off Lundy's Lane. This house is still standing. Being childless, he adopted his wife's nephew who was an orphan and whose godfather was General Sir Isaac Brock. This lad, Thomas Brock Fuller, followed his foster father into the ministry and later became first bishop of the Diocese of Niagara. Mr. Leeming died June 1, 1863 in his 78th year and is buried in Holy Trinity Churchyard in Chippawa.

Extensive renovations were done in 1895. The box pews were replaced by bench-styled open pews. The reading desk was replaced by a walnut lectern. A furnace, new prayer desk, carpeting and wainscotting completed the extensive remodelling.

General renovations were made about every decade; electricity was installed about 1900; a new organ in 1914; a new furnace and safety glass to protect the stained-glass windows were installed in 1920. The up-dating continued and still goes on as needed.

The Rev. Charles Leycester Ingles was appointed Curate to Mr. Leeming in 1848. He came to assist the ill Rev. Leeming. Upon Rev. Leeming's death he was appointed the Rector. Shortly after this appointment, Holy Trinity separated from St. John the Evangelist and All Saint's Churches.

From about 1853 to 1882 Sunday School was held in the home of the Church Warden, so that the Church could be 'kept tidy'. In 1882 Mrs. H.C. Mewburn donated the land for the Sunday School building.

Canon George Armstrong Bull replaced Rev. Ingles as rector in 1885. Rev. G.B. Bull (Mr. Bull's son) was appointed as his Curate.

A new organ was acquired replacing the original 1845 seraphine and the rectory was built in 1888.

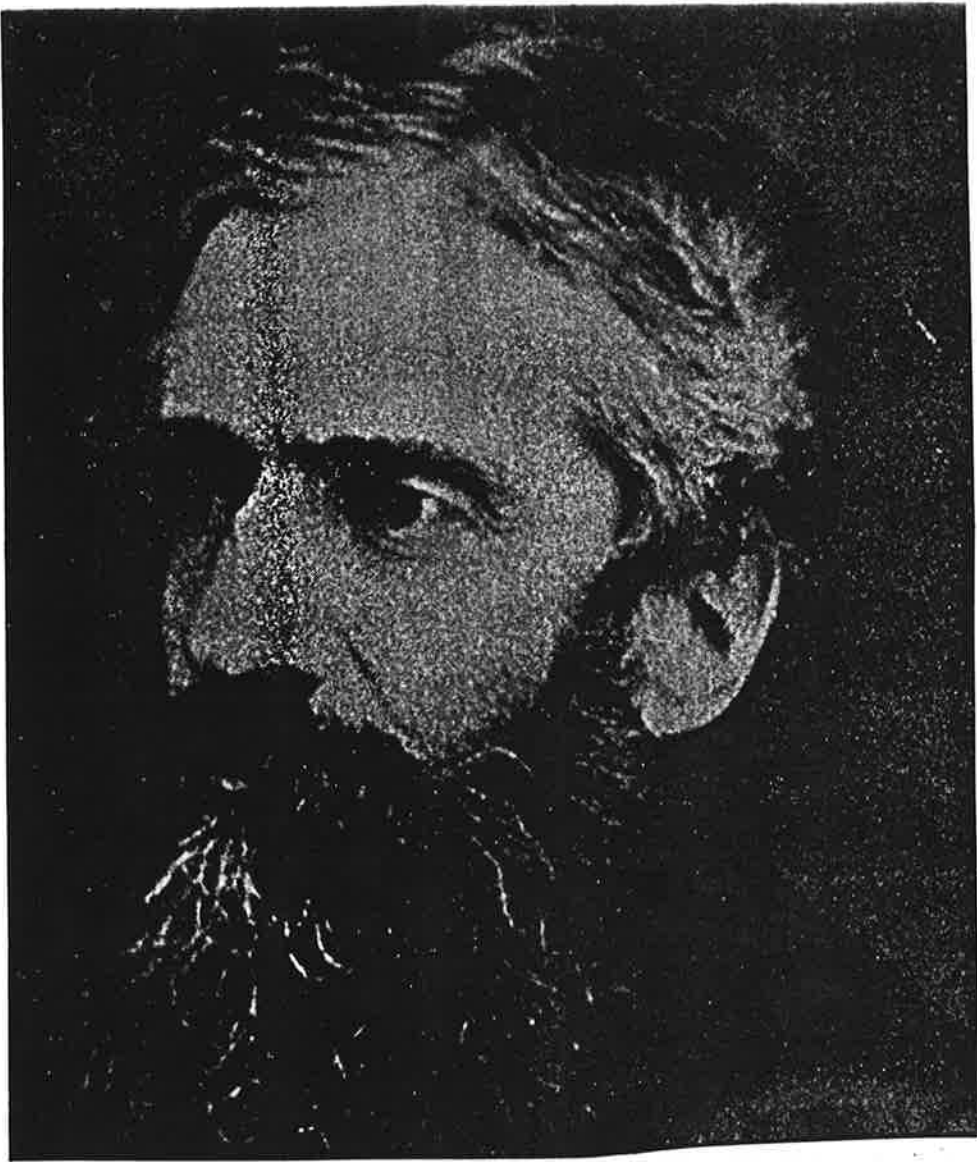
Canon Bull resigned in 1902 due to declining health. At this time St. John separated from All Saint's to become a separate parish under Canon Thomas Motherwell.

In 1916 due to afternoon services at St. Saviour in Queenston, Sunday School was held in the morning for the first time under the direction of Rev. C.E. Belt.

A new church was built in 1957 and a new hall in 1961. The old Church building was deconsecrated in 1962, with the Altar Rail, Communion Rail, Pulpit and Reredos from the church being donated to Upper Canada Village.

For quite a number of years now the parish has resembled many other suburban parishes with a fanastic growth of it's members who's roots go deep into the soil of the Niagara Peninsula.

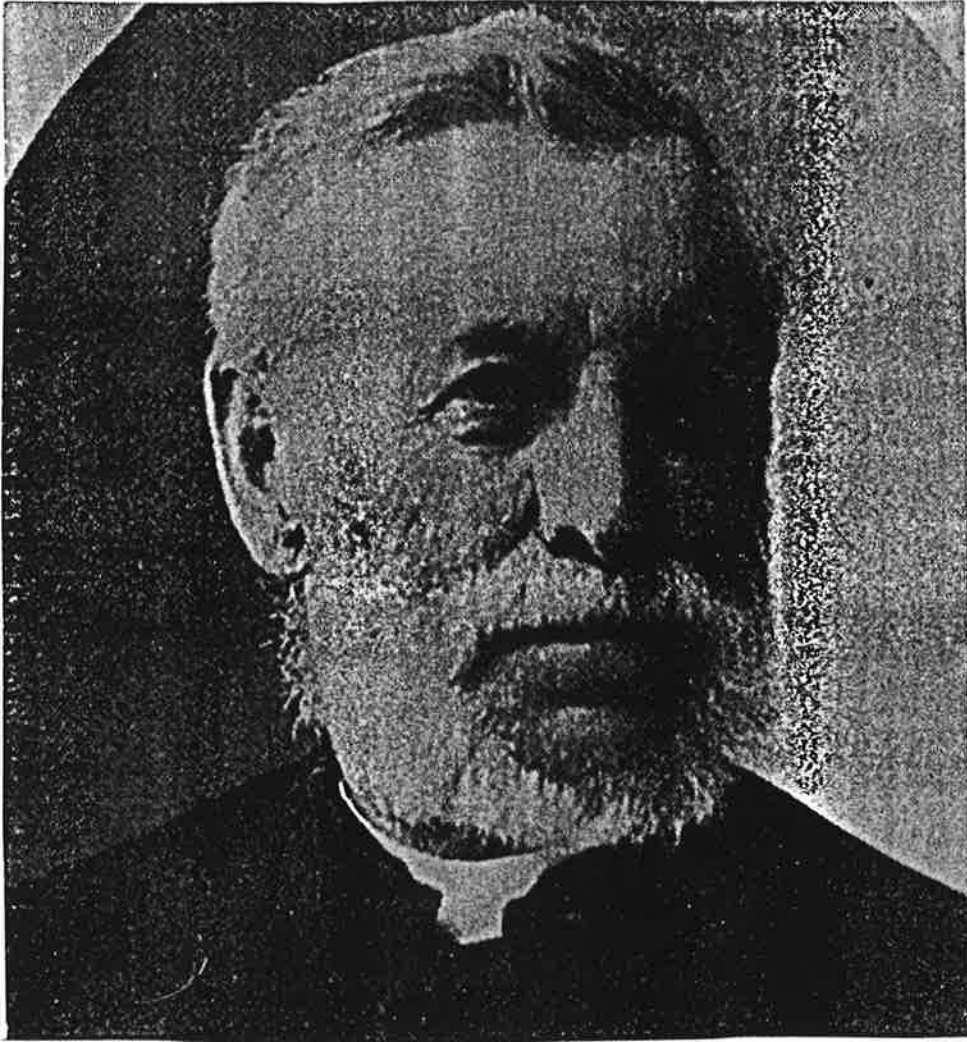
Today the restored Old St. John's Anglican Church is known as Stamford Green Heritage Columbarium. (It is a non-denominational depository for cinerary urns containing human remains).



**REVEREND CHARLES LEYCESTER INGLES, M.A.**

Rev. Charles Ingles was born in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia in 1822, into the family of Rev. C. L. Ingles. He was ordained by Bishop Strachan of Toronto, July 30, 1848 and immediately came to the parish of Chippawa to minister during the illness of Rev. Wm. Leeming. He remained as curate and was appointed rector of St. John's, Stamford and All Saints, Niagara Falls on the death of Mr. Leeming in 1863. On Aug. 26, 1851 he married Jemima, daughter of General George Murray, a man prominent in the early life of Niagara Falls. Mr. Ingles and his father-in-law were instrumental in building All Saints Church. He died Nov. 3, 1885 in his 64th year and was buried in All Saints Churchyard.

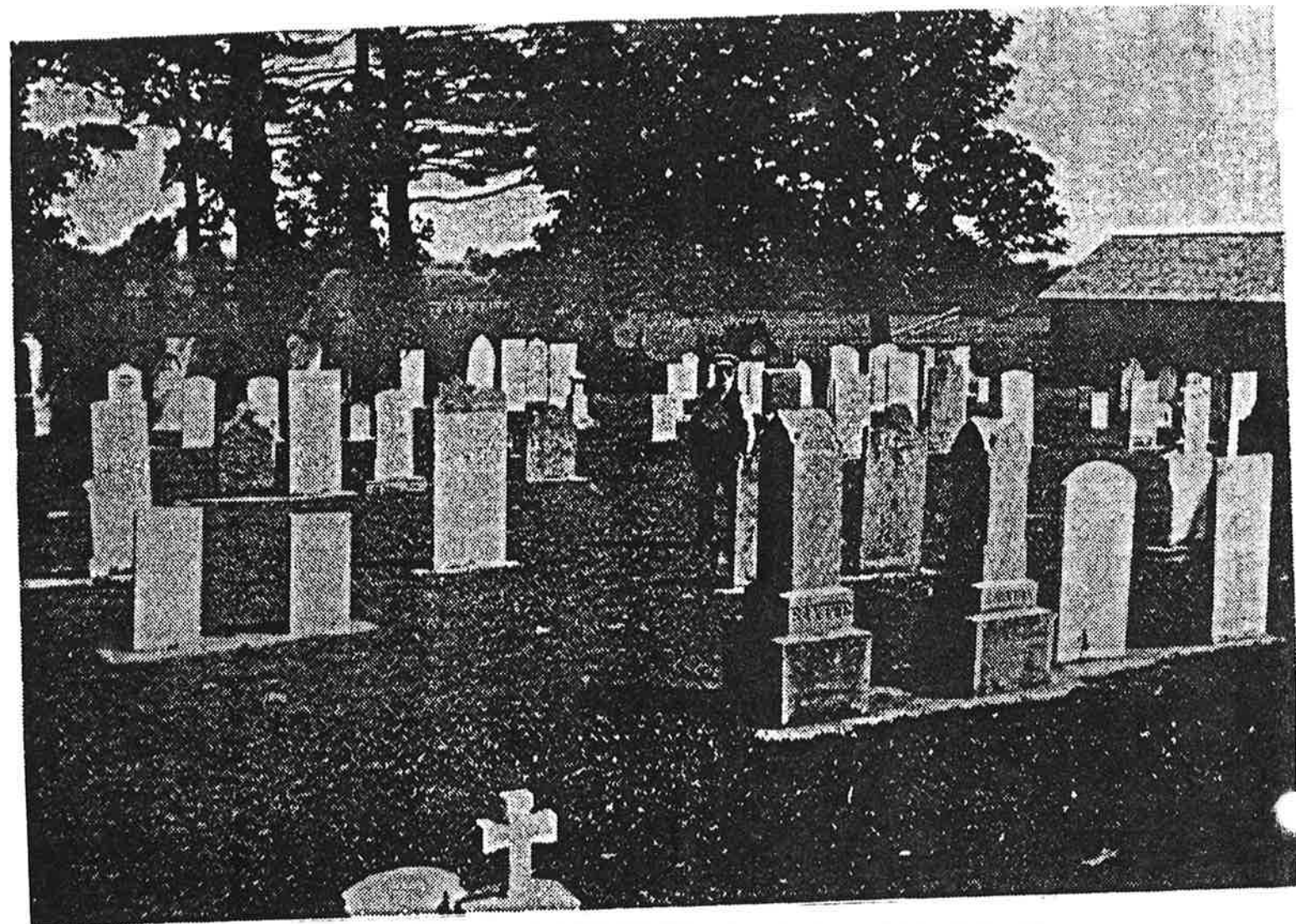




**REVEREND GEORGE ARMSTRONG BULL, M.A.**

Canon Bull was born in Dublin, Ireland, May 16, 1828 and came as an infant to Canada. He was educated at Dean Geddes' school for boys in connection with Christ's Church Cathedral in Hamilton and later studied in Cobourg and Toronto. He was ordained by Bishop Strachan in Toronto in 1852 but served his ministry entirely in Niagara and principally at two parishes. He was at Barton and Glanford parishes near Hamilton for 32 years and at St. John's Stamford and All Saint's Niagara Falls for 17 years, from 1885 to 1902. He retired from the active ministry in May, 1902 and returned to Hamilton where he died July 21st, 1909 in his 82nd year.

Canon Bull was a noted historian and the founder and first president of the Lundy's Lane Historical Society. He was also president of the Ontario Historical Society from 1894 to 1897.
