## **SUNDAY PRAYERS CHANGE AT 11 AM SERVICES**

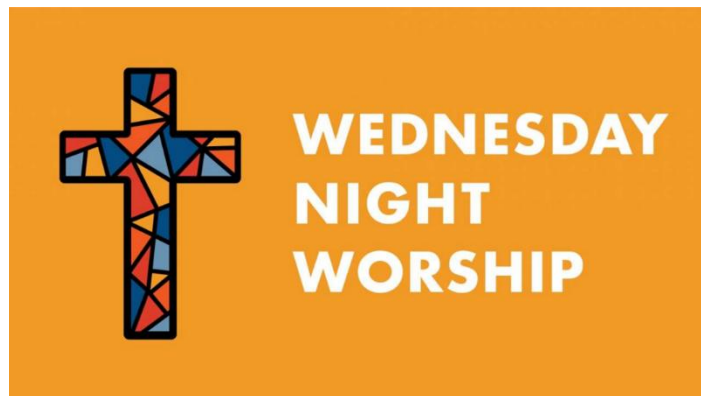
